【Biography of Mr. Tan Kah Kee】

Mr. Tan Kah Kee was born on October 21, 1874 into an overseas business family in Jimei (formerly a small village of Tongan County), Xiamen, Fujian. At the age of 17, he travelled to Singapore to work at his father's shop. After years of hard work, he gained great success and was known as the Rubber Magnate of Southeast Asia. Bearing in mind that education is vital to the development of the nation and that running a school is the due responsibility of the people, he returned home in 1913. He established Jimei Schools including Kindergarten, Primary School, Middle School, Teachers' College, Fishery School, Navigation School, Business School, Agronomy School and Xiamen University thereafter. During the anti-Japanese war, he was elected councilor for Nanyang Overseas Chinese Chamber for Relief—a fund-raising charity for the refugees of the motherland. He made tremendous contributions to the victory of the Chinese anti-Japanese war and gained high respect from compatriots at home and abroad. In 1949, Tan Kah Kee moved back to China and was appointed Vice Chairman of the CPPCC, Member of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, and the first Chairman of the Chinese Federation of Overseas Chinese. He passed away on August 12, 1961.

Tan Kah Kee is a renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader, an outstanding entrepreneur, an educator, and social activist. With deep love for his motherland, he invested all his fortunes in education and offered his selfless service for the benefit of humanity. He made tremendous contributions to the independence and liberation of the motherland. Mao Zedong praised him as the Flag of the Overseas Chinese and Glory of the nation. In memory of Tan Kah Kee for his special contributions, on March 11, 1990, the International Asteroid Center and Asteroid Nomination Committee named Asteroid 2963 after him as Tan Kah Kee Star.

【A letter from President Xi Jinping】

His spirit of hard work and self-striving to attain a goal, his virtue of putting the nation and the country first, and his concern for the development of the country, as well as his sincerity to the cause of education are always worth learning.

The realization of the great rejuvenation of China as a nation is the common aspiration of Chinese at home and abroad. It is also the lifelong pursuit of Mr. Tan Kah Kee and our forefathers. I hope the overseas Chinese will continue to promote the "Tan Kah Kee's Spirit"—being patriotic and striving for the realization of the dream of the national rejuvenation—together with the people in the motherland.

Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

Tan Kah Kee Scholarship was set up in 2017 to further implement the spirit of the letter of Correspondence of General Secretary Xi Jinping to Jimei Alumni Association, to better promote the monumental contributions of the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, to inherit and to carry forward the Tan Kah Kee Spirit as well as to attract and encourage the outstanding overseas Chinese students and Chinese descendants to pursue their studies in Xiamen.

The scholarship mainly comes from the dividend yield from Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. of Jimei Schools Committee to support the overseas Chinese students, Chinese descendants from the countries of "Maritime Silk Road" or Jimei Schools alumni descendants in Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan to study in 7 schools and universities including Xiamen University, Jimei University, Huaqiao University (Xiamen campus), Xiamen University of Technology, Xiamen Ocean Vocational College, Jimei Industrial School and Jimei Middle School.

Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen

Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen is a non-public funded foundation whose income mainly comes from the donation from Jimei Schools Committee, Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. as well as people from all walks of life.

The objective of the Foundation is to set up Tan Kah Kee Scholarship in order to fund the overseas Chinese students and Jimei Schools alumni descendants from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan for the pursuit of their studies in Xiamen, to honor the outstanding teachers and students from schools and universities of Jimei Schools Village, to fund the academic workshop on publication and research of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, and to help excellent but poverty-stricken students who deserve the award.

Funding Criteria

The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

Overseas Chinese descendants:

1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
2. Master's degree students: 60,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 to 3 years.
3. Bachelor's degree students: 50,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 to 5 years.
4. Advanced vocational school students: 50,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
5. Secondary vocational school students: 30,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
6. Senior high school students: 40,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
7. Non-degree trainees (including language students): 30,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 1 year.
8. Short-term program trainees: 3,000 RMB/person/month, granted for the learning duration.

Students from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese:

Each student will be granted 2000 RMB as living allowance each month, ten months per year. Other expenses such as tuition, teaching materials, accommodation allowance and insurance will be transferred to the relevant schools and universities. The duration of the funds complies with the length of schooling.

Entry Requirements

1. Applicants should be descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of Maritime Silk Road, friendly to China and in favor of the "One China" policy. Students from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan should be descendants of Jimei alumni, persisting in the "One country, two systems" policy. All applicants should be in good health.

2. Applicants should abide by the laws and regulations of Chinese government and meet the admission requirements of the relevant school.

3. Applicants' qualifications and age limit:

(1) Applicants for secondary vocational schools or senior high schools should obtain the junior high school diploma or higher level certificates and be under the age of 18. (2) Applicants for bachelor's degree or advanced vocational schools should obtain the senior high school diploma or relevant certificates and be under the age of 30. (3) Applicants for master's degree program should obtain bachelor's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 35. (4) Applicants for the doctoral degree program should have master's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 40. (5) Applicants for the non-degree training courses and short-term studies should be under the age of 40 and meet the qualification requirement of the relevant schools and universities.

4. Applicants for the degree education program should acquire the Chinese language proficiency required by relevant faculties.

5. Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

Application Period and Access

Time for Application:

International students: 2022 Dec. 1st - 2023 May 15th (the application time of each university and school may be different)

Chinese students from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan and foreign countries:

2023 Aug. 15th - 2023 Sept. 15th.

Assessment and Distribution

1.The assessment of the scholarship is carried out under the principle of openness,fairness,justness and merit-based selection.The Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation evaluates the candidates recommended by relevant schools and universities by the means of centralized review and submits the assessment materials to the leading group of the Scholarship.

After further examination,the Group determines the final awardees and the funding limits and confirms the decision by publishing the notice on the websites of Jimei Schools Committee as well as those of the schools and colleges.The relevant schools and universities release the notice to the awardees.

2.An enrollment ceremony for the scholarship winners will be held and the award certificates be distributed.

3.After the tuition,accommodation and insurance fees are deducted,the rest of the scholarship for degree and non-degree education students will be paid by month as the living expenses.

4.An annual assessment for the awardees should be conducted to decide whether the scholarship can be extended according to their performance at school.In case of the student's violation of the laws of the Chinese government or the regulations of the school,their pursuit of activities that do not conform with their identity,the fact of providing false materials,taking an improper learning attitude or failing to meet the academic requirements of relevant schools,the scholarship can be suspended under the assessment and evaluation by leading group of the Educational Foundation for further examination.

Regulations for the implementation of Tan Kah Kee Scholarship were revised on January 2,2019.

Application Guide to Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships for 2023 Intakes

University Profile

Xiamen University (XMU), founded in 1921 by renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, was the first Chinese university established by an overseas Chinese person. On the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the founding of XMU, Xi Jinping, General Secretary of the CPC Central Committee, President of the PRC and Chairman of the Central Military Commission, sent a congratulatory letter to the University. The letter commented that XMU has a glorious tradition, and that over the last hundred years, XMU has upheld the founding aspirations of the patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, and forged a unique institutional spirit defined by a commitment to patriotism, reform, self-betterment and science. In the process, XMU has built distinctive institutional characteristics and produced countless outstanding graduates, making significant contributions to national prosperity, public wellbeing and the global dissemination of Chinese culture.

PURSUE EXCELLENCE AND STRIVE FOR PERFECTION

The phrase "Pursue Excellence" can be traced to the Book of Changes, a canonized Confucian classic containing the following sentence: "As the movement of the heavens is forever dynamic, so the superior man pursues excellence all his life." This phrase was hung over the podium at XMU's inauguration ceremony on April 6, 1921 and stressed by Mr. Tan Kah Kee as a commitment to excellence when the University was being founded. It reaffirmed China's determination to resume its rightful place in the world.

The phrase "Strive for Perfection" is taken from the chapter of Great Learning in the Classic of Rites, in which great learning is defined as the ability to explain and exemplify virtues, to show love and concern for people, and to strive for perfection. It was the motto of the University designated by President Lim Boon Keng when XMU was a private university.

The emblem of Xiamen University was designated by Mr. Tan Kah Kee upon the founding of the University. At the top of the circle are the four traditional Chinese characters for "Xiamen University", while at the bottom are the words of "Xiamen University" in Latin - UNIVERSITAS AMOIEMSIS. The three stars on the shield represent spirit, universe and human beings, which are the three major elements in nature in the theory of traditional Chinese philosophy. The gate at the center of the shield represents the University's commitment to opening its doors to talent. The four Chinese characters on the ribbon mean "striving for perfection", which is part of XMU's motto.

Xiamen University currently comprises Siming Campus, Zhangzhou Campus, Xiang'an Campus and XMU Malaysia. XMU consists of a graduate school, six academic divisions, 33 schools and 16 research institutes. Its disciplinary system covers 12 disciplinary categories, including philosophy, economics, law, education, literature, history, science, engineering, medicine, management, art and cross-disciplines. XMU boasts five first-level and nine second-level national key disciplines. There are 32 postdoctoral programs, 37 first-level disciplines authorized for the conferral of doctoral degrees, 46 first-level disciplines authorized for the conferral of master's degrees, and eight independent second-level cross-disciplines. In addition, XMU confers professional doctoral degrees in two authorization categories and professional master's degrees in 29 authorization categories. In 2022, six XMU disciplines – education, chemistry, marine science, biology, ecology and statistics – were included in the nation's list of disciplines for achieving world-class status. XMU ranks among ESI's global top 1% in 19 disciplines, namely, chemistry, material science, engineering, physics, clinical medicine, molecular biology and genetics, biology and biochemistry, environment and ecology, computer science, geology, botany and zoology, mathematics, microbiology, economics and business, neuroscience and behavioral science, immunology, general social science, pharmacology and toxicology, and agronomy, with chemistry, materials science and engineering in ESI's global top 1‰.

XMU currently has a faculty of nearly 3,000, of whom 74.3% are full or associate professors. There are 32 academicians (including 18 with dual appointments), one "senior humanities professor", four fellows of the World Academy of Sciences, two members of the Academic Division of the Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences, and 30 heads of national key R&D programs, 29 "distinguished professors under the Chang Jiang Scholars Program", two "specially appointed scholars", 23 "national outstanding young scholars", 60 recipients of the National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars, 38 "leading scholars under the National Special Support Program for High-Level Talent", 17 "top-notch young scholars", and 58 recipients of the National Science Fund for Outstanding Young Scholars. Moreover, XMU boasts 11 national innovative research groups, two central projects in fundamental disciplines under the National Natural Science Foundation, nine innovation teams under the Ministry of Education (MOE), and six faculty members who are "national renowned teachers".

XMU currently has an enrollment of more than 44,000 students, including over 20,000 students in bachelor's degree programs, 18,000 in master's degree programs, and 5,000 in doctoral degree programs. XMU's internal quality assurance (IQA) system was included UNESCO's Program of Exploring Good Principles and Innovative Practices in IQA Systems in Higher Education, becoming the only university in not only China but also East Asia to be selected for the program. XMU received one first prize and 15 second prizes at the sixth, seventh and eighth National Awards for Teaching Achievements in Higher Education. Eight of its disciplines were included in MOE's Exceptional Students Training Program 2.0 for Fundamental Sciences, and 11 programs (13 projects) were included in MOE's Excellent Talent Cultivation Program. Moreover, 44 programs of study at XMU were selected for achieving national first-class status, and 44 courses were included the nation's first group of first-class undergraduate courses. Additionally, XMU has been designated by MOE as a demonstration center for the teaching and research of ideological-political courses, two of its courses have been designated by MOE as model ideological-political course. At present, XMU has six national-level experimental teaching demonstration centers, three national-level virtual simulation experimental teaching centers, one national-level clinical teaching and training demonstration center, and three national-level field practice education centers for university students. In 2018-2022, 46 XMU professors served on the MOE Academic Steering Committee for Higher Education Institutions.

XMU has more than 300 research institutes, including two national-level collaborative innovation centers, four national key laboratories, one national engineering technology research center, one national engineering laboratory, two national-regional joint engineering research centers, three national-regional joint engineering laboratories, one national innovation platform for industry-academia integration, one national field scientific observation research station, one national high-end think tank, five MOE key laboratories, three MOE engineering research centers, one MOE field scientific observation research station, and five MOE key centers for research in humanities and social sciences.

XMU implements a comprehensive global outreach strategy. The University has signed cooperation agreements with 259 overseas universities and is engaged in substantive exchanges and cooperation with 52 world-renowned universities. Actively involved in international Chinese education, XMU has built 14 Confucius Institutes and 48 Confucius Classrooms in 12 countries on five continents, the highest numbers with the most extensive geographic coverage among Chinese universities on the List of "Double First-Class" Universities. Moreover, XMU is a leading center of Taiwan research and is on the forefront of cross-strait academic and cultural exchanges. In July 2014, XMU Malaysia broke ground, making XMU the first Chinese university to open an international campus. Hailed as a jewel on the crown of the "Belt and Road Initiative", XMU Malaysia offers 22 bachelor's degree programs, seven master's degree programs and four doctoral degree programs. It currently has an enrollment of more than 6,000 students and a faculty and staff of over 500. Most of the students come from the 33 countries and regions along the "Belt and Road".

In the next hundred years, inspired by the congratulatory letter of General Secretary Xi Jinping for its centennial, XMU will strive to establish itself as an internationally recognized university for advanced research and achieve its second centennial goal of a distinctive world-class Chinese university. By 2035, XMU is expected to have joined the ranks of world-class universities, and by the middle of this century, when the PRC celebrates its 100th anniversary, XMU is expected to have become a leading world-class university.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be ethnic Chinese from countries along the Maritime Silk Road (particularly in Southeast Asia), and hold a valid foreign regular passport.
2. Applicants shall adhere to the One China Principle, be friendly to China, abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese Government, and be in good health.
3. Educational background and age limits (as of September 1, 2023):

(1) Bachelor's degree programs: holding a high school diploma or above and being under the age of 30;

(2) Master's degree programs: holding a bachelor's degree or above and being under the age of 35;

(3) Doctoral degree programs: holding a master's degree or above and being under the age of 40.

Notes:

(1) Applicants who have been awarded any other scholarship are not eligible for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships.

(2) Former Chinese citizens who have acquired foreign nationality and their children of foreign nationality as well as individuals of foreign nationality whose parents are Chinese citizens, need to pass both the preliminary review of citizenship status made by XMU before being admitted and the final judgement of citizenship made by the entry and exit administration department of China's public security authorities after the study in XMU begins. Applicants who fail to pass the preliminary review or verification of citizenship will be deemed to have voluntarily relinquished their eligibility for admission, as well as the subsequent academic registration that they may obtain. Language Proficiency Requirements

Applicants should submit valid HSK certificate. For programs in Humanities, Economics, Management, Law, Arts and Traditional Chinese Medicine, HSK band 5 with a score of 210 or above is required. For programs in Sciences, Engineering and Medicine, HSK band 4 with a score of 210 or above is required. As for HSK requirements for Chinese language major of Overseas Education College, please refer to OEC website at <http://oec.xmu.edu.cn>. Applicants whose previous degree programs were taught in Chinese may provide the medium-of-instruction certificate issued by the previous institution as a substitution.

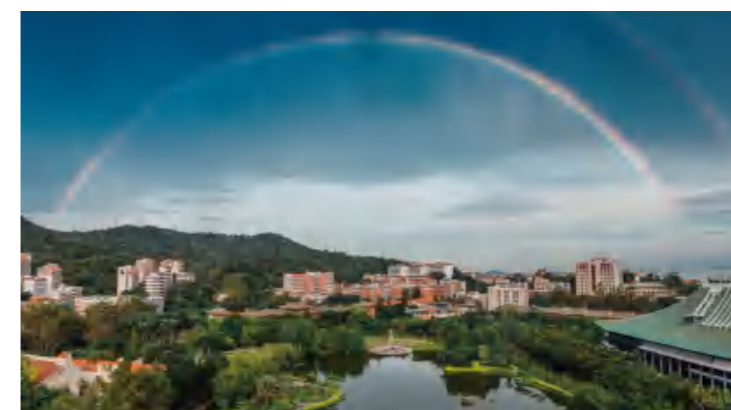
(1) Doctoral students will have the tuition waiver during the 4th academic year.

(2) Tuition fees are subject to change upon approval by price regulators.

2. Accommodations: Due to the limited availability of on-campus accommodations, priority will be given to students whose scholarship includes accommodation subsidies, and the remaining on-campus accommodations will be given to students whose scholarship does not include accommodation subsidies, as well as to self-financed students. The international student apartments on the Siming campus offer 2-person rooms, with accommodation fees per person ranging from RMB 30 to RMB 70 per day. Students on the Xiang'an campus will be accommodated in suites, each of which comprises 4 double-rooms. The accommodation fee is RMB 1,600-4,000 per academic year. Students who fail to secure on-campus accommodation are expected to make arrangements for off-campus accommodation on their own before arrival. The monthly rental of apartments near the Siming campus is around RMB 2,500 per room. For enquiries, call + 86 (0)592 2183606. 3. Cost of living: RMB 1,000-1,500 per month.

4. Cost of insurance: RMB 800 per year.



Duration of Scholarships

1. Bachelor's degree programs: 4 or 5 years;
2. Master's degree programs: 2 or 3 years;
3. Doctoral degree programs: 4 years.

Note: Scholarship recipients will be subject to annual review in accordance with the relevant management regulations of the scholarships. Those who pass the review can continue to apply for or enjoy the scholarships in the next academic year. Those who fail the review will be suspended or disqualified from the scholarships. The specific regulations and methods of the annual review shall be subject to the latest notice issued in the current year.

Scholarship Quota

20 students for bachelor's degree programs, 15-25 students for master's degree programs, and 3-5 for doctoral degree programs.

Note: Final quota will be determined by Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee.

Scholarships Coverage

1. Standard of scholarships: RMB 50,000 per year for bachelor's degree programs; RMB 60,000 per year for master's degree programs; RMB 70,000 per year for doctoral degree programs.

2. Distribution of scholarships: Scholarships will be first applied to the deduction of tuition and insurance fees, and the rest will be paid monthly.

Note: If living on campus, scholarship recipients need to pay on-campus accommodation fees and utility costs according to the University's regulations.

Application Period: December 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023

Application Procedures

Application for the scholarships will be considered only after the applicant has been admitted to Xiamen University.

Applicants shall complete online application at <http://application.xmu.edu.cn> and upload the scanned copies of the Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships, Certification of Chinese Origin and related supporting documents (<https://admissions.xmu.edu.cn/cn/info/1136/1997.htm>). The Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships should be completed in Chinese or English with handwritten signature from the applicant. The Certification of Chinese Origin should bear the stamp of the recommending organization and handwritten signature from the person in charge. In general, mailing of paper-based application documents is not required.

Selection and Notification

Applications for the scholarships will be evaluated on a competitive basis through an open, fair and impartial process. XMU will prepare a short-list of candidates for the scholarships and submit it to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation for evaluation and then to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee for approval. Scholarship decisions will be made on the basis of the applicants' academic performance, language proficiency, research competence, letters of recommendation and overall merits.

The final results will be published at <https://admissions.xmu.edu.cn> in mid-July. Scholarships awardees will be notified via email. Admission Notices and Visa Application Forms for Study (JW202) will be sent out afterwards.

Overview

Jimei University (JMU), one of the key universities located in Xiamen City, Fujian Province, is a multi-disciplined university. It is jointly constructed by the Ministry of Transport, the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Fujian Provincial Government and the Xiamen Municipal Government. The university started with the Teacher's Department of Jimei School founded in 1918 by the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader, Chen Jiageng (Tan Kah-Kee), and the Fisheries Department, Business Department of Jimei School founded in 1920. It has a history of 104 years. Its motto "Sincerity and Perseverance" is a precious spiritual heritage handed down by Tan Kah Kee. It has formed the characteristics and advantages of marine-oriented disciplines such as navigation and fishery, which has undergone a long and glorious history and enjoys great fame far and wide.

Motto

Jimei University takes "sincerity and perseverance" as its school motto, "sincerity for the country, seeking truth from facts, and impartiality; perseverance in dealing with things, perseverance, and hard work." This is the precious spiritual legacy left by the school's owner, Mr. Tan Kah Kee, to Jimei School.

School Features

Jimei University has a complete school-running system for doctoral students, master students and undergraduates, and has formed the characteristics and advantages of marine-oriented disciplines such as navigation and aquatic products.

Sino-foreign Cooperation And Exchanges

Jimei University attaches great importance to exchanges and cooperation with foreign universities and research institutes, and has successively cooperated with more than 100 universities and research institutes in 20 countries including the United States, Canada, Australia, the United Kingdom, Germany, Italy, Japan, South Korea, and Singapore.

Advantageous Disciplines And Faculty

JMU has 20 colleges with 76 undergraduate programs in nine disciplines, i.e. Engineering, Agronomy, Economics, Administration, Education, Science, Literature, Law and Fine Arts. At present, there are 4 first-class discipline doctoral degree authorization points, 15 first-class discipline master's degree authorization points and 18 master's professional degree authorization points (categories). It has 8 first-class key disciplines in Fujian Province (including 2 characteristic key disciplines) and 1 post-doctoral research mobile station in fisheries. The ship and ocean engineering discipline group, aquatic and food engineering discipline group were selected as the peak disciplines in Fujian Province, and the shipping and port logistics discipline group, regional economy and management discipline group, Fujian and Taiwan sports culture discipline group and mathematical discipline group were selected as the plateau disciplines in Fujian Province. Currently, it has more than 29,400 students and over 1500 faculty members, among which, there are 33 national talents including 13 academicians (2 full-time) and 266 provincial and ministerial talents.

Teaching Facilities

Jimei University covers an area of 2,344 acres, with a school building area of 1.03 million square meters. The new campus was selected as one of the "100 Classic and Excellent Projects" for the 60th anniversary of the founding of New China, and it is the only project selected by universities across the country. The school environment is beautiful and elegant, and the climate is pleasant. With red walls and green tiles, water pavilions and pavilions hidden among green trees and flowers, it is an ideal place for countless students from home and abroad to study.

Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

Brief introduction to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

▶ Tan Kah Kee Scholarship was set up in 2017 to further implement the spirit of the letter from General Secretary Xi Jinping of the CPC Central Committee to Jimei Alumni Association, to better promote the monumental contributions of the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, who is praised as "the Flag of the Oversea Chinese and the Glory of the Nation", to inherit and to carry forward the Tan Kah Kee Spirit as well as to attract and encourage the outstanding overseas Chinese students and Chinese descendants to pursue their studies in Xiamen.

Scholarship Funding Quota

▶ 20 undergraduate students, 25 graduate students (together with Xiamen University, Huaqiao University, Xiamen University of Technology), 5 doctoral students (together with Xiamen University, Huaqiao University). The final funding quota will be adjusted by the Tan Kah Kee scholarship leading group according to the actual application.

Funding Criteria

▶ The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
2. Master's degree students: 60,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 or 3 years
3. Bachelor's degree students: 50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 or 5 years

Entry Requirements

▶ 1. Applicants should be descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from countries along the Maritime Silk Road who are in favor of the "One China" policy, friendly to China and in good health.
2. Applicants should abide by the laws and regulations of Chinese government and meet the admission requirements of the relevant school.

3. Educational background and age limits (as of September 1, 2023):
 - 3.1 Bachelor's programs: hold a high school diploma or above and be under the age of 30;
 - 3.2 Master's programs: hold a bachelor's degree or above and be under the age of 35;
 - 3.3 Doctoral programs: hold a master's degree or above and be under the age of 40.
4. language proficiency requirements for degree programs

Applicants for programs taught in Chinese should achieve International Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or above, and within the validity period. Applicants who have finished their highest diploma completely in Chinese are exempted from proof of Chinese Language Proficiency Test, but they must present a medium-of-instruction certificate.



5. In accordance with Article 5 of the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China, a person whose parents are both Chinese citizens and have both settled abroad, or one of whose parents is a Chinese citizen and has settled abroad, shall not have Chinese citizenship if he or she has acquired foreign citizenship at birth. If such a person applies to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as an international student, in addition to meeting the University's all other application requirements, he or she is required to have held a valid foreign passport for at least 4 years and have actually resided in a foreign country for at least 2 years in the past 4 years (as of April 30, 2023) (9 months of residence in a foreign country counts as a full year). The dates of the entry and exit stamps in the passport will be followed in the determination of the actual length of foreign residence. This requirement is also applicable to residents of the Chinese Mainland, Taiwan, Hong Kong or Macao who have emigrated to a foreign country and obtained foreign citizenship and are applying to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as international students.

6. Only after being officially recognized by the Division of Exit and Entry Administration of Public Security Bureau as foreign citizens, can foreign citizens of Chinese origin apply for Residence Permit in China and register their academic records as international students.

7. Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

▶ Applicants should apply to the Admission office of Jimei university before May 10th, 2023.

List and Admission

"Huaqiao University Admission Notice" and "Foreign Student Visa Application Form" will be sent to the admitted students. Freshmen should go to the Local Chinese Embassy and Consulate to apply for X1 study visa, and register on time according to the time of starting school for freshmen. Those who fail to register for the school within two weeks without reason will be automatically disqualified from admission, and should return the "Foreign Student Visa Application Form" received from our school. After enrollment, a physical examination will be organized by the school. Only those who pass the examination will be able to formally qualify for admission.

Training Management

An annual assessment for the awardees will be conducted to decide whether the scholarship qualification can be extended. The assessment is carried out in accordance with the charter formulated by Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation and the "Management Rules for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship of HQU" and school's relevant system. Those who pass the assessment can continue to apply for or enjoy the scholarships in the next academic year, otherwise the qualifications will be canceled.

The awardees cannot change school, major, or extend study period in principle. If there are special circumstances in which the awardees have to change major or school, or extend the study period, they should apply to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation first, and can change major or school, or extend the study period only after approval.

Support One China policy, be friendly to one's country of origin.
2. The health condition complies with the relevant provisions of the "Entry and Exit Administration Law of the People's Republic of China", and a medical examination certificate of the past 6 months must be submitted.
3. Have a letter of recommendation by an overseas Chinese association including one's kin group or by an influential overseas Chinese or person of Chinese origin in the applicant's country of residence.
4. Education and age
Applicants for bachelor's degree courses are required to have senior high school certificate/diploma or above, less than 30 years of age;
Applicants for master's degree courses are required to have undergraduate degree or certificate or above, less than 35 years of age;
5. Applicants should reach Level 4 of the International Standard for Chinese Language Proficiency (hereinafter referred to as HSK). High school students who use Chinese as the language of instruction can be exempted from the HSK Level 4 certificate, but they must submit the proof that Chinese is the language of instruction .
6. Recipients of Chinese Government Scholarship or other relevant scholarships or grants are generally not eligible for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.

(VI) Overview: Xiamen Ocean Vocational College is subordinate to the Education Department of Fujian Province. It was founded by the renowned patriotic Overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee in 1920. The college history includes Jimei College Fisheries Department, Jimei Advanced Fisheries Navigation College, Jimei Fisheries Academy and Fujian Jimei Fisheries College (a national key technical secondary school). It is one of the earliest cradles for training aquatic navigation technical talents in China. Besides, it is a national defense education characteristic college of the Ministry of Education, a civilized campus in Fujian Province, an excellent school of Fujian Huang Yanpei Vocational Education Award, a demonstration vocational college in Fujian Province, a demonstration modern vocational college in Fujian Province, a demonstration college of innovation, entrepreneurship and creativity education in Fujian Province, and a supporting unit of the National Natural Science Foundation. It has been selected as a project construction unit of the “Fujian Provincial High-level Vocational Colleges and Specialty Construction Plan”.

In the course of a hundred years of running the college, we have taken “Sincerity and Perseverance” as the motto, carried forward the Tan Kah Kee spirit, and cultivated a large number of high-quality technical and skilled talents for the development of the country and Fujian’s marine industry. Conditions of enrollment objects

- (II) Students who apply for our college must obtain a diploma from a senior middle school or a technical secondary school with an equivalent degree or above, be 18-30 years old (before September 1, 2023), and hold a valid foreign ordinary passport.
 - (1) Residents of Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan who come to China to study as foreign students after immigrating to foreign countries must hold a valid foreign passport for at least 4 years, and have a record of actual residence in foreign countries for at least 2 years in the last 4 years (by April 30, 2023) (the actual residence in foreign countries for at least 9 months in a year can be counted as one year, subject to the entry and exit signatures).
 - (2) According to relevant regulations, foreign Chinese (including former Chinese citizens who have joined foreign nationality and their descendants of foreign nationality, and descendants of foreign nationality of Chinese citizens) can only apply for residence permits for foreigners and register their student status as foreign students after passing the nationality identification of the Exit and Entry Administration of the public security organization. Those who fail to pass the nationality determination will be disqualified from admission.
 - (III) Obey the laws and regulations of the Chinese government. The students shall be healthy and their physical conditions must comply with the provisions of the Notice on Printing and Distributing the Guidance on the Physical Examination for Enrollment of Ordinary Colleges and Universities issued by the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Health, the China Disabled Persons' Federation and other relevant documents. Those who fail the physical examination will not be admitted.
 - (IV) Have the basic ability to use Chinese and Chinese characters for communication, and the level of Chinese language must reach Level 4 or above of the International Chinese Proficiency Standard.

Student application time and files

Funding standard for Xiamen Ocean Vocational College Scholarship for international students: 20,000 Yuan/Person/Academic year.

The foreign students admitted to our college need to be reviewed according to the procedure, and the scholarship will be granted on a monthly basis after passing the review.

Scholarships can be used to pay for tuition, accommodation, insurance, teaching materials, living expenses, etc.

Scholarships cannot be shared at the same time. Applicants can only get one of the scholarships at most.

Our college will comprehensively review the academic performance and language ability of scholarship applicants. Brief Introduction to Jimei Industrial College

Jimei Industrial College was initially founded by Mr. Chen Jiageng (Tan Kah Kee) in 1920 as Jimei School of Business. The college is located in the picturesque coastal city, Xiamen. JIC is also adjacent to the Xiamen Jimei Learning Village. As a member of Jimei Schools, the college's strong cultural ambience reflects the spirit and value set up by Mr. Chen Jiageng. It's beautiful learning environment, comfortable living accommodation and qualified teaching faculty make it the most preferred vocational school in Xiamen.

Jimei Industrial College covers an area of 236,000 square meters of school premises. The construction area of 171,400 square meters. JIC has a total fixed asset value of 610 million yuan. Among its 358 officially budgeted faculty, 328 are professional teachers, 117 with senior professional title, including 2 high-titles, and 149 with intermediate professional title. Besides, there are 115 "Double-qualified" instructors and 92 master-degree teachers. 2023 Admissions Policy of Xiamen Jimei High School of Fujian for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Program

About Our School

Located in Jimei School Village, Jimei High School, founded by Mr. Tan Kah Kee in 1918, is the alma mater of numerous overseas Chinese, and is reputed as the “cradle of overseas Chinese students”. Now, the school stands as the Chinese Language and Culture Education Base in Fujian Province, one of the First Provincial Key High Schools, Provincial Tier 1 Standard School, Provincial Model Institution, Winner of Provincial May 1 Labor Medal, Provincial Advanced Quality Education School, one of the first Provincial Model High Schools, and a public secondary school directly under the jurisdiction of Xiamen Municipal Government. It is open to all the applicants in Fujian Province and overseas. Jimei High School aims to better implement the message in General Secretary Xi Jinping’s letter to Jimei Alumni Association, recognize the great achievements of Mr. Tan Kah Kee (the Flag of Overseas Chinese and the Glory of the Nation), and carry forward his spirit. Its international students have achieved stunning results in the college entrance examination and the high school entrance examination. For example, Liang Zhenni from Indonesia was admitted to Tsinghua University in 2007, and Tang Zhongzhe from Canada and He Riyi from Argentina to Peking University in 2014 and 2019. Students of Tan Kah Kee Scholarship have also been admitted to famous universities like Peking University, Sun Yat-sen University, Zhejiang University, Xiamen University, Jimei University, etc.

Situated between hills and the sea, Jimei High School boasts picturesque scenery, superior conditions and advanced facilities. Its new and old campuses cover an area of nearly 200,000 square meters with accommodate landmark buildings designed by Mr. Tan Kah Kee, making the school listed as a key historical and cultural site under state protection. Upholding the Spirit of Tan Kah Kee, it strives to become a national model high school featuring Chinese cultural characteristics, and join the rank of world-class high school in the new era.



Enrollment Targets

Echoing China's the Belt and Road Initiative, the Program is targeted at Grade 10 (freshmen) students in countries along the "21st-Century Maritime Silk Road", especially those with exceptional academic records and moral qualities, who are the descendants of overseas Chinese in Southeast Asia or of the School's alumni in Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan.

Admission Criteria

Applicants for the Tan Kah Kee Scholarship should meet the following criteria:

1. Being the descendants of overseas Chinese in countries along the "21st-Century Maritime Silk Road", upholding the one-China principle, with respect for their own native countries and in good health. Those from Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan should be the descendants of Jimei High School's alumni, upholding "one country, two systems", and in good health.
2. Abiding by China's laws and regulations and meeting the School's admission criteria.
3. Age and education background:
Holding a diploma of junior high school or above, and no more than 18 years old in principle.
4. Chinese proficiency:
Holding a certificate of HSK Level 4 or above, or the equivalent. Able to understand high school courses taught in Chinese, including Chinese Language and Literature, Mathematics, English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Politics, History, Geography, Information Technology, General Technology, Music, Fine Arts and Physical Education. The grant of the diploma is conditional on passing the provincial general examinations of all the courses.

Materials to be Submitted by Applicant:

1. Application Form for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.
2. Photocopy of passport or other identification certificate.
3. 2-inch color bareheaded photo.
4. Notarized latest diploma and transcripts in Chinese or English. (If the original is in Chinese or English, it does not need to be notarized.)
5. Relevant Chinese proficiency certificate.
6. A testimonial or recommendation letter from the last school of graduation.
7. A recommendation letter from a local overseas Chinese association or a local overseas Chinese with influence; (or from a local Jimei Alumni Association branch or the Jimei Alumni Association, for the descendants of Jimei High School's alumni in Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan).
8. A study plan in China written in Chinese.
9. Applicants under 18 must submit the Notary Certificate of Guardian in China.



Scholarship Amount

1. The Program offers each enrolled student a scholarship of RMB40,000 per academic year for 3 years. The Leading Group will specify the quota for the scholarship, and determine the winners based on the list of candidates recommended by the admissions department.
2. The scholarship shall be used for tuition, accommodation, textbooks, notebooks, living expenses, etc.

Source of Funds

The Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Program is mainly funded by the Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. of the Committee of Jimei Schools. In principle, half of its annual dividend income will be used in this regard. The Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation is responsible for the collection, management, distribution and supervision of the fund.

Education and Management

Jimei High School is responsible for the education and management of its students and sets much stricter standards for graduation than for admission, according to relevant Chinese regulations on the education of international students and students from Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan as well as the Program's characteristics and requirements.

It formulated the Measures for Administration of International Students Status and the Measures for the Management of International Students. Also, it lists Spirit of Tan Kah Kee, Overview of Chinese Culture and History of Overseas Chinese as compulsory courses, and organizes 1 activity per semester to honor the Spirit of Tan Kah Kee.

2. February to March: Acceptance of application materials.
3. Late March: Ending of the acceptance.
4. April to May: Review of applications, to be completed by Mid-May.
