Biography of Mr. Tan Kah Kee

October 21, 1874 -- August 12, 1961

Biography of Mr. Tan Kah Kee

Mr. Tan Kah Kee was born on October 21, 1874 to an overseas business family in Jimei (formerly a small village of Tongan County), Xiamen, Fujian. At the age of 17, he travelled to Singapore to work at his father's shop. After years of hard work, he gained great success and was known as the 'Rubber Magnate' of the Southeast Asia. Bearing in mind that 'education is vital to the development of the nation and running a school is the due responsibility of the people, he returned home in 1913. He established Jimei Schools including Kindergarten, Primary School, Middle School, Teachers' College, Fisheries, Navigation, Business, Agronomy and Xiamen University thereafter. During the anti-Japanese war, he was elected councilor for Nanyang Overseas Chinese Chamber for Relief – a Fund-raising for Charity for the Refugees of the Motherland. He made tremendous contributions to the victory of the Chinese anti-Japanese war and gained high respect from compatriots at home and abroad. In 1949, Tan Kah Kee moved back to China and was appointed Vice Chairmen of the CPPCC, Member of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, and the first Chairman of the Chinese Federation of Overseas Chinese. He passed away on August 12, 1961.

Tan Kah Kee is a renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader, an outstanding entrepreneur, an educator, and social activist. With deep love for his motherland, he invested all his fortunes in education and offered his selfless service for the benefit of humanity. He made tremendous contributions to the independence and liberation of the motherland. Mao Zedong praised and called him "the flag of the overseas Chinese and the glory of the nation". In memory of Tan Kah Kee for his special contributions, on March 11, 1990, the International Asteroid Center and Asteroid Nomination Committee named him Asteroid 2963 'Tan Kah Kee Star.'

A Letter of Correspondence from President Xi Jinping

In October, 2014, on the occasion of the 140th Anniversary of the birth of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, General Secretary of the CPC, President of PRC and Chairman of the Military Commission of CPC Xi Jinping sent a letter of correspondence to Xiamen Jimei Alumni Association, calling for the overseas Chinese to promote the "Tan Kah Kee Spirit" – be patriotic and strive for the realization of the dream of the national rejuvenation – together with the people in the motherland.

The following is the content of the letter by President Xi:

On this special occasion of the 140th Anniversary of the birth of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, I cherish my profound memory of him and extend my sincere greetings to his families and relatives.

Mr. Tan Kah Kee is "the Flag of the Overseas Chinese and the Glory of the Nation." I worked in Fujian for many years, and I fully acknowledged the great contributions he had made to his motherland, especially for his hometown, Fujian. Being the leader and a good example for overseas Chinese, he is patriotic and devoted himself to education as a career. He joined the national salvation movement, promoted unity among overseas Chinese, and strived for the liberation of the nation. His spirit of hard work and self-striving to attain a goal, his virtue of putting the nation and the country first, and his concern for the development of the country, as well as his sincerity to the cause of education are always worth learning.

The realization of the great rejuvenation of China as a nation is the common aspiration of Chinese at home and abroad. It is also the lifelong pursuit of Mr. Tan Kah Kee and our forefathers. I hope the overseas Chinese will continue to promote the "Tan Kah Kee's Spirit" – be patriotic and strive for the recognition of the dream of the national rejuvenation – together with the people in the motherland.

Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

► Tan Kah Kee Scholarship was set up in 2017 to further implement the spirit of the letter of Correspondence of General Secretary Xi Jinping to Jimei Alumni Association, to better promote the monumental contributions of the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, to inherit and to carry forward the Tan Kah Kee Spirit as well as to attract and encourage the outstanding overseas Chinese students and Chinese descendants to pursue their studies in Xiamen.

The scholarship mainly comes from the dividend yield from Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. of Jimei Schools Committee to support the overseas Chinese students, Chinese descendants from the countries of "Maritime Silk Road" or Jimei Schools alumni descendants in Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan to study in 7 schools and universities including Xiamen University, Jimei University, Huaqiao University (Xiamen campus), Xiamen University of Technology, Xiamen Ocean Vocational College, Jimei Industrial School and Jimei Middle school.

Brief Introduction to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen

► Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation of Xiamen is a non-public funded foundation whose income mainly comes from the donation from Jimei Schools Committee, Hong Kong Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. as well as people from all walks of life.

The objective of the Foundation is to set up Tan Kah Kee Scholarship in order to fund the overseas Chinese students and Jimei Schools alumni descendants from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan for the pursuit of their studies in Xiamen, to honor the outstanding teachers and students from schools and universities of Jimei Schools Village, to fund the academic workshop on publication and research of Mr. Tan Kah Kee, and to help excellent but poverty-stricken students who deserve the award.

Funding Criteria

► The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

Overseas Chinese descendants:

1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
2. Master's degree students: 60,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 to 3 years.
3. Bachelor's degree students: 50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 to 5 years.
4. Advanced vocational school students: 50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
5. Secondary vocational school students: 30,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
6. Senior high school students: 40,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 years.
7. Non-degree trainees (including language students): 30,000 RMB/person/academic year, granted for 1 year.
8. Short-term program trainees: 3,000RMB/person/month, granted for the learning duration)

Students from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese: Each student will be granted 2000RMB as living allowance each month, ten months per year. Other expenses such as tuition, teaching materials, accommodation allowance and insurance will be transferred to the relevant schools and universities. The duration of the funds complies with the length of schooling.

Application Conditions

▶ 1. Descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of Maritime Silk Road who are in favor of the 'One China' policy, friendly to China and in good health. Students from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region should be the descendants of Jimei alumni, in favor of the 'One country, two systems' policy and in good health.

2. Abiding by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government and meeting the relevant admission requirements of the application school.

3. Applicants' qualifications and age limit:

(1) Applicants for secondary vocational schools or senior high schools should obtain the junior high school diploma or higher level certificates and be under the age of 18.

(2) Applicants for bachelor's degree or advanced vocational schools should obtain the senior high school

diploma or relevant certificates and be under the age of 30.

(3) Applicants for master's degree program should obtain bachelor's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 35.

(4) Applicants for the doctoral degree program should have master's degree or higher level certificates and be under the age of 40.

(5) Applicants for the non-degree training courses and short-term studies should be under the age of 40 and meet the qualification requirement of the relevant schools and universities.

4. Applicants for the degree education program should acquire the Chinese language proficiency required by relevant faculties.

5. Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

International students: Feb.1st - May 15th.

Chinese students from Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan and foreign countries: Aug.15th - Sept.15th.

Basic material

1. An application Form for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.
2. The photocopy of the passport or other identification.
3. The authenticated degree certificate and the transcript.
4. HSK certificates, students(except those from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan and Overseas Chinese) applying for the English teaching courses should provide the Certificates of English language proficiency.
5. An Evaluation Form from the school of graduation or a Letter of Recommendation.
6. A letter of reference from overseas Chinese celebrity of the home country (for descen dants of the Jimei schools alumni in Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan region, a letter of reference from Jimei Alumni Committee of the region or Jimei Alumni Association is required.)
7. A study plan.
8. Other materials required by the schools applied.



Assessment and Distribution

1. The assessment of the scholarship is carried out under the principle of 'openness, fairness, justness and selecting the best'. The Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation evaluates the candidates recommended by relevant schools and universities by the means of centralized review and submits the assessment materials to the leading group of the Scholarship. After further examination, the Group determines the final awardees and the funding limits and confirms the decision by publishing the notice on the websites of Jimei Schools Committee as well as those of the schools and colleges. The relevant schools and universities release the notice to the awardees.

2. An enrollment ceremony for the scholarship winners will be held and the award certificates be awarded.

3. After the tuition, accommodation and insurance fees are deducted, the rest of the scholarship for degree and non-degree education students will be paid by month as the living expenses.

4. An annual assessment for the awardees should be conducted to decide whether the scholarship can be extended according to their performance at school. In case of the student's violation of the laws of the Chinese government or the regulations of the school, their pursuit of activities that do not conform with their identity, the fact of providing false materials, taking an improper learning attitude or failing to meet the academic requirements of relevant schools, the scholarship can be suspended under the assessment and evaluation by leading group of the Educational Foundation for further examination.

Regulations for the implementation of Tan Kah Kee Scholarship were revised on January 2, 2019.

XMU, established in 1921 by renowned patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Tan Kah Kee, is the first Chinese university founded by an overseas Chinese. The University is a comprehensive institution of higher education directly affiliated with China's Ministry of Education, and it has recently been chosen for inclusion in the Chinese Government's Program of Building World-Class Universities and World-Class Disciplines.

With nearly a century of robust growth, XMU today is a nationally-ranked and internationally-recognized comprehensive university. Its long and proud tradition of scholarly excellence and its leadership in a broad range of disciplines have earned it a prestigious reputation as the "Strength of Southern China". Since its inception, XMU has produced more than 400,000 graduates, and over 60 academicians of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering have studied or worked at XMU.

In recent years, in parallel with the steady rise of China's national strength and international influence, XMU has advanced by leaps and bounds, approaching the world's highest standard for academic disciplines, scientific research, and educational quality. The University was placed among the world's top 400 institutions in various authoritative world university rankings, such as THE, QS, US News and ARWU and is expected to rise higher in the ranking charts on its way to world-class university status. 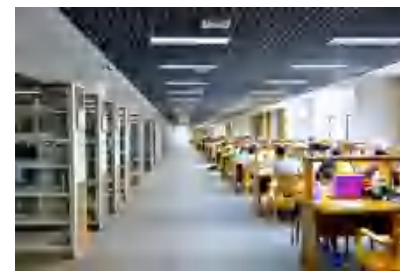
Tan Kah Kee Scholarship

Eligibility

- ▶ 1. Applicants must be ethnic Chinese from countries along the Maritime Silk Road (particularly in Southeast Asia), and possess a valid foreign regular passport.
- 2. Applicants shall adhere to the One China Principle, be friendly to their mother country, abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese Government, and be in good health.
- 3. Educational background and age limits (as of September 1, 2022):
 - (1) Bachelor's programs: hold a high school diploma or above and be under the age of 30;
 - (2) Master's programs: hold a bachelor's degree or above and be under the age of 35;
 - (3) Doctoral programs: hold a master's degree or above and be under the age of 40.

Notes:

- (1) Applicants who have been awarded any other scholarship are not eligible for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships.
- (2) Former Chinese citizens who have acquired foreign nationality and their children of foreign nationality as well as individuals of foreign nationality whose parents are Chinese citizens, need to pass both the preliminary review of citizenship status made by XMU before being admitted and the final judgement of citizenship made by the entry and exit administration department of China's public security authorities after the study in XMU begins. Applicants who fail to pass the preliminary review or verification of citizenship will be deemed to have voluntarily relinquished their eligibility for admission, as well as the subsequent academic registration that they may obtain. Language Proficiency Requirements

- ▶ 1.Applicants should submit valid HSK certificate. For programs in Humanities, Economics, Management, Law, Arts and Traditional Chinese Medicine, HSK band 5 with a score of 210 or above is required. For programs in Sciences, Engineering and Medicine, HSK band 4 with a score of 210 or above is required. Applicants whose previous degree programs were taught in Chinese could provide the medium-of-instruction certificate issued by the previous institution as a replacement.
- ▶ 2.Applicants for bachelor's program under Overseas Education College need to have a Chinese proficiency certificate of HSK 3 or above.

Note:

- (1) Doctoral students will have the tuition waiver during the 4th academic year.
- (2) Tuition fees are subject to change upon approval by price regulators.

▶ Accommodation fee

The international student apartments on the Siming campus offer 2-person rooms, with daily accommodation fees per person ranging from RMB30 to RMB70. Students on the Xiang'an campus will be accommodated in suites, each of which comprises 4 double-rooms. The accommodation fee is RMB 1,600-4,000 per academic year. Please refer to the updated notice of the year for the specific accommodation fees.

Cost of living: RMB 1,000-1,500/month.

Cost of insurance: RMB 800/year.

Duration of Scholarships

- 1. Bachelor's programs: 4 or 5 years;
- 2. Master's programs: 2 or 3 years;
- 3. Doctoral programs: 4 years.

Note: Scholarship recipients shall participate in the annual review in accordance with the relevant management regulations of the scholarships. Those who pass the review can continue to apply for or enjoy the scholarships in the next academic year. Those who fail the review will be suspended or disqualified from the scholarships. The specific regulations and methods of the annual review shall be subject to the latest notice issued in the current year.



Scholarships Quota

- ▶ 20 for bachelor's programs, 10-25 for master's programs and 3-5 for doctoral programs.
Note: Final quota will be determined by Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee.

Scholarships Coverage

▶ 1. Standard of scholarships: RMB 50,000/year for bachelor's programs; RMB 60,000/year for master's programs; RMB 70,000/year for doctoral programs.

2. Distribution of scholarships: Scholarships will be first used for deducting tuition fee and insurance, and the rest will be issued monthly.

Note: If living on campus, scholarship recipients need to pay the on-campus accommodation fee and utility costs according to the University's regulations.

Application Procedures

▶ Application for the Scholarships will be considered only after the applicant has been admitted to Xiamen University.

Applicants shall complete online application at <http://application.xmu.edu.cn> and upload the scan copy of Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships and Certification of Chinese Origin. The Application Form for Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships should be completed in Chinese or English with handwritten signature from the applicant. The Certification of Chinese Origin should bear the stamp of the recommending organization and handwritten signature from the person in charge.

Selection and Notification

▶ Applications for the scholarships will be evaluated on a competitive basis through an open, fair and impartial process. XMU will prepare a short-list of candidates for the scholarships and submit it to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation for evaluation and then to the Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Committee for approval. Scholarship decisions will be made on the basis of the applicants' academic performance, language proficiency, research competence, letters of recommendation and overall merits.

The final results will be published at <https://admissions.xmu.edu.cn> in mid-July. Scholarships awardees will be notified via email. Admission Notices and Visa Application Forms for Study (JW202) will be sent out afterwards.

Application Guide to Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Of JIMEI University for 2022

Jimei University (JMU), one of the key universities located in Xiamen City, Fujian Province, is a multi-disciplined university with a history of more than 100 years. It is jointly constructed by the Ministry of Transport, the Ministry of Natural Resources, the Fujian Provincial Government and the Xiamen Municipal Government. It was founded by the famous patriotic overseas Chinese leader Mr. Chen Jiageng (Tan Kah-Kee). JMU is one of the earliest universities of its kind in Fujian Province entitled to enroll international students, overseas Chinese students, and students from Hong Kong, Macao, Taiwan.

Overview

Its motto "Sincerity and Perseverance" is a precious spiritual heritage handed down by Mr. Chen Jiageng, the founder of Jimei Schools, which has undergone a long and glorious history and enjoys great fame far and wide.

Jimei university has formed a complete educational system including bachelor's, master's and doctor's degrees. The hallmarks of these degrees are majors such as Navigation、 Fisheries.

JMU puts much emphasis on its international exchange and cooperation program. It has carried out a wide range of academic exchange and research cooperation with more than 100 universities and research institutions in more than 20 countries including the United States, Canada, Australia, Britain, Germany, Italy, Japan, Korea, and Singapore.

JMU has 20 colleges with 74 undergraduate programs in nine disciplines, i.e. Engineering, Agronomy, Economics, Administration, Education, Science, Literature, Law and Fine Arts. At present, there are 4 first-class discipline doctoral degree authorization points, 15 first-class discipline master's degree authorization points and 18 master's professional degree authorization points (categories). It has 8 first-class key disciplines in Fujian Province (including 2 characteristic key disciplines) and 1 post-doctoral research mobile station in fisheries. The ship and ocean engineering discipline group, aquatic and food engineering discipline group were selected as the peak disciplines in Fujian Province, and the shipping and port logistics discipline group, regional economy and management discipline group, Fujian and Taiwan sports culture discipline group and mathematical discipline group were selected as the plateau disciplines in Fujian Province. Currently, it has more than 28,500 students and over 1500 faculty members, among them, there are 29 national talents including 10 academicians (2 full-time) and 177 provincial and ministerial talents.

Jimei University covers an area of about 2344 mu with a floor space of over 1,030,000 square meters. In 2009, its new campus architecture group was awarded as one of "China's Top 100 Construction Projects" over the last 60 years since the founding of the People's Republic of China (PRC), making it the only awarded university project in China. Its beautiful natural scenery, unique architectural style and pleasant climate make it the ideal place for young people from both home and abroad to study.

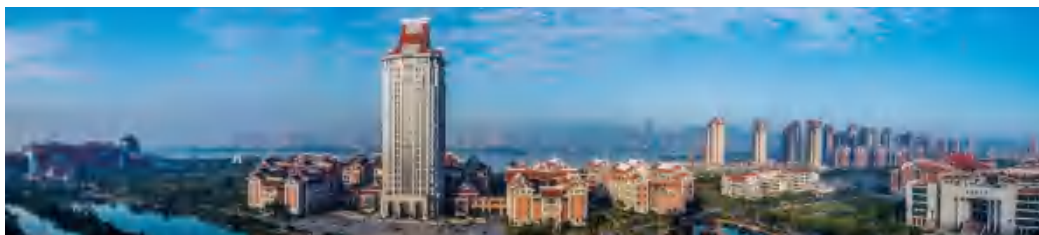
Scholarship funding quota

▶ 20 undergraduate students, 25 graduate students(together with Xiamen University,Huaqiao University,Xiamen University of Technology), 5 doctoral students(together with Xiamen University,Huaqiao University).The final funding quota will be adjusted by the Tan Kah Kee scholarship leading group according to the actual application.

Funding Criteria

▶ The scholarship covers such expenses as tuition, accommodation allowance, teaching materials, insurances, and living expenses. The granted amount should be determined by the degree levels and categories of the applicant.

1. Doctoral degree students: 70,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 3 to 4 years.
2. Master's degree students:60,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 2 or 3 years.
- 3.Bachelor's degree students:50,000RMB/person/academic year, granted for 4 or 5 years.



Eligibility:

- ▶ 1. Descendants of the overseas Chinese and Chinese descendants from the countries of "Maritime SilkRoad" who are in favor of the "One China" policy, friendly to China and in good health.
- ▶ 2. Abiding by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government and meeting the relevant admission requirements of Jimei University.
- ▶ 3. Educational background and age limits:
 - (1).Bachelor's programs: hold a high school diploma or above and be under the age of 30;
 - (2).Master's programs: hold a bachelor's degree or above and be under the age of 35;
 - (3).Doctoral programs: hold a master's degree or above and be under the age of 40.
- ▶ 4. language proficiency requirements for degree programs
Applicants for programs should achieve International Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or above, and within the validity period. Applicants who have finished their highest diploma completely in Chinese are exempted from proof of Chinese Language Proficiency Test, but they must present a medium-of-instruction certificate.
- ▶ 5. In accordance with Article 5 of the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China, a person whose parents are both Chinese citizens and have both settled abroad, or one of whose parents is a Chinese citizen and has settled abroad, shall not have Chinese citizenship if he or she has acquired foreign citizenship at birth. If such a person applies to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as an international student, in addition to meeting the University's all other application requirements, he or she is required to have held a valid foreign passport for at least 4 years and have actually resided in a foreign country for at least 2 years in the past 4 years (as of April 30, 2022) (9 months of residence in a foreign country counts as a full year). The dates of the entry and exit stamps in the passport will be followed in the determination of the actual length of foreign residence). This requirement is also applicable to residents of the Chinese Mainland, Taiwan Hong Kong or Macao who have emigrated to a foreign country and obtained foreign citizenship and are applying to study in a bachelor's degree program at JMU as international students.
- ▶ 6. Foreign citizens of Chinese origin only after being officially recognized by the Division of Exit and Entry Administration of Public Security Bureau as foreign citizens, can they apply for Residence Permit in China and register their academic records as international students.
- ▶ 7. Awardees of other scholarships should not be granted Tan Kah Kee scholarship.

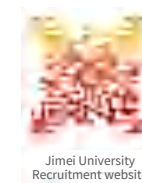

Application Guide to Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Scholarships Of Huaqiao University for 2022

Huaqiao University (HQU), founded in 1960, is a comprehensive university, directly under the United Front Work Department (UFWD) of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Central Committee. It is the National Base for Chinese Language Teaching, the National Base for Cultural Quality Education of College Students, the National Demonstration University for Deepening Innovation and Entrepreneurship Education Reform and the National Demonstration University for Teacher Evaluation Reform.

It is the first institution of higher education named after Huaqiao (Overseas Chinese), and one of the first universities that enroll overseas students. Educating students both morally and intellectually, HQU aims at producing high-quality talent with innovative spirit, practical ability, global vision and social responsibility. HQU is one of the universities that recruit the largest number of overseas students in China.



Part One: Brief Introduction

It currently houses 26 colleges with 90 departments and centers, among which 11 are national first-class undergraduate programs, 9 are provincial first-class undergraduate programs and 16 have achieved international and domestic profession certifications. Strengthening the discipline construction, HQU offers 11 categories with a coordinately developed discipline system that combines arts with science, integrates science with engineering and couples engineering with management.

Part Seven: Scholarship Selection

▶ The assessment of the scholarship will be carried out under the principle of 'openness, fairness, justness and selecting the best'. Our school will take the applicant's academic performance, language level, academic ability, recommendation letter and comprehensive quality into consideration, and select merit scholarship candidates, and then submit the candidates list to Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Leading Group. After centralized review, the Group determines the final awardees.

The results of the scholarship is expected to be determined and published on the websites of Jimei School Committee as well as our admissions website in mid-to-late July. The awardees will receive an official email notification from our school.

"Huaqiao University Admission Notice" and "Foreign Student Visa Application Form" will be sent to the admitted students. Freshmen should go to the Local Chinese Embassy and Consulate to apply for X1 study visa, and register on time according to the time of starting school for freshmen. Those who fail to register for the school within two weeks without reason will be automatically disqualified from admission, and should return the "Foreign Student Visa Application Form" received from our school. After enrollment, a physical examination will be organized by the school. Only those who pass the examination will be able to formally qualify for admission.



Part Nine: Training Management

▶ An annual assessment for the awardees will be conducted to decide whether the scholarship qualification can be extended. The assessment is carried out in accordance with the charter formulated by Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation and the "Management Rules for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship of HQU " and school's relevant system. Those who pass the assessment can continue to apply for or enjoy the scholarships in the next academic year, otherwise the qualifications will be canceled.

The awardees cannot change school, major, or extend study period in principle. If there are special circumstances in which the awardees have to change major or school, or extend the study period, they should apply to Tan Kah Kee Educational Foundation first, and can change major or school, or extend the study period only after approval.

- 3.Education and age Applicants for bachelor's degree courses are required to have senior high school certificate/diploma or above, less than 30 years of age; Applicants for master's degree courses are required to have undergraduate degree or certificate or above, less than 35 years of age;
- 4.Applicants should reach Level 4 of the International Standard for Chinese Language Proficiency (hereinafter referred to as HSK). High school students who use Chinese as the language of instruction can be exempted from the HSK Level 4 certificate, but they must submit the proof that Chinese is the language of instruction .
- 5.Recipients of Chinese Government Scholarship or other relevant scholarships or grants are generally not eligible for Tan Kah Kee Scholarship.
- 6.Applicants are required to be able to undertake distance learning in exceptional circumstances

Scholarship

- ▶ 1. The Tan Kah Kee Scholarship covers tuition fees, accommodation cost and comprehensive medical insurance.
- 2. Tan Kah Kee Scholarship recipients are entitled to living allowances for ten months per year, to be delivered monthly as follows:
2600 yuan per month for Master's students
2500 yuan per month for Bachelor's students
- Note: Living allowances will be paid to students after they register in China and pass the qualification examination

In its 100 year of operation, the school has cultivated a large number of high-quality technical and technical talents for the development of the country and Fujian's maritime industry, and its outstanding alumni have spread all over the country and the world, enjoying a wide reputation at home and abroad, with the motto of "sincerity and perseverance" and the spirit of Jia Geng. In April 2000, When General Secretary Xi Jinping was a governor of Fujian Province, he wrote an inscription for the 80th anniversary of the school-" Chun Feng Hua Yu, Tao Li Man Yuan", placing high hopes on the construction and development of the college. Wan Xiang, the Vice Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, and other national, ministerial, and provincial leaders have visited the school and adequately affirmed the efficient development of the college.

The College has two campuses, Siming and Xiang'an, covering an area of 712 mu, with a total planning area of more than 1000 mu. There are 9 secondary colleges, namely, the Maritime College, the Ocean Biology College, the Ocean Mechanical and Electrical College, the Information Engineering College, the International Trade College, the Ocean Culture and Tourism College, the Public Education

College, the Marxism College and the Continuing Education College, with 14000 students and more than 20000 non-academic education students each year. More than 40 famous experts and professors from home and abroad, including Canadian academician Edward McBean and academician Xiao Huining, are employed as part-time or special professors; international students of Chinese descent are recruited from countries along the Belt and Road. Signed strategic cooperation agreements with Taiwan Ocean University, Kaohsiung University of Science and Technology, Taipei University of Marine Science and Technology and other sea-related universities in Taiwan to carry out educational and academic exchanges such as mutual visits of teachers and students.

Admission Conditions

2.1 The applicants should be the descendant of overseas Chinese from the countries along the "Maritime Silk Road", and should advocate the "One-China Policy" and be friendly to their ancestral home countries.

2.2 The applicants must obtain a diploma of senior high school or equivalent secondary school or above. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens aged between 18 and 30 (until September 1, 2022) with a valid foreign general passport.

2.2.1 Residents of mainland China, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan who immigrated to other countries and then study in China as a foreign student must hold a valid foreign passport for 4 years or more. And in the past 4 years (Until April 30, 2022), there have been records of actually living abroad for more than 2 years (actually living abroad for 9 months in a year can be calculated in one year, certified by entry and exit seals)

2.2.2 According to the relevant regulations, foreign Chinese (including former Chinese citizens who have joined foreign nationality and their descendants of foreign nationality, and foreign descendants of Chinese citizens) must pass the nationality identification of the entry and exit administration of the Public Security Bureau. Then they can apply for foreign residence permit and register as a foreign student. Those who fail to pass the nationality identification will be disqualified.

2.3 The applicants should comply with the laws and regulations of the Chinese government. The applicants' physical conditions must in line with the relevant documents issued by the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, the National Health Commission of the People's Republic of China, and China Disabled Persons' Federation, mainly the "Guidance Opinions on Physical Examination of Enrollment in Colleges and Universities". Those who are not qualified for physical examination are not accepted.

2.4 The applicants should have the basic ability to communicate in Chinese and Chinese characters. Applicants for programs taught in Chinese should achieve International Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK) band 4 or above.

The scholarships can be used for tuition, accommodation, insurance, textbooks, living expenses and other expenses.
Applicants can only receive one of the scholarships.
Xmoc will comprehensively review the academic performance and language proficiency of scholarship applicants. According to the scholarship selection method, adhere to the principle of standardization, objectivity and fairness, Xmoc will select the candidates for the scholarship from the admitted students, and report it to the higher authorities of the college for approval. - ▶ 2.The scholarship shall be used for tuition, accommodation, textbooks, notebooks, living expenses, etc.

Source of Funds

- ▶ The Tan Kah Kee Scholarship Program is mainly funded by the Chiyu Banking Corporation Ltd. of the Committee of Jimei Schools. In principle, half of its annual dividend income will be used in this regard. The Xiamen Tan Kah Kee Education Foundation is responsible for the collection, management, distribution and supervision of the fund.

- ▶ Jimei High School is responsible for the education and management of its students and sets much stricter standards for graduation than for admission, according to relevant Chinese regulations on the education of international students and students from Chinese Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan as well as the Program's characteristics and requirements.

It formulated the Measures for Administration of International Students Status and the Measures for the Management of International Students. Also, it lists Spirit of Tan Kah Kee, Overview of Chinese Culture and History of Overseas Chinese as compulsory courses, and organizes 1 activity per semester to honor the Spirit of Tan Kah Kee.
